- 3. GUARANTEE 100% OF DONNA KARAN'S CLOTHING BE MADE IN LAW ABIDING FACTORIES AND THAT 75% BE MADE IN OUR LOCAL COMMUNITIES IN ORDER TO STOP THE THREATS AGAINST WORKERS WHEN THEY SPEAK OUT.**
